Home learning and reading

We will send home a name and number recognition cards. Please encourage your child to recognise and form letters from their name. Use the number cards to practise recognising and writing numbers.

We will also send home key words. These words are sight words, they are not to be decoded by sounding out using phonics, these words will support your child's reading.

YOU MUST read at home every night for 10 minutes, this is essential for your child's progress. Reading records will be checked to ensure children are reading with adults.

Keep reading through the summer holidays!

To start the academic year in reception we have a settling in period. This allows us to build a relationship with each child and ensure all children feel comfortable and confident in school.

Please ensure you have read through your transition timetable and are aware of the days and times your child is expected to be in school.

Meet the Teachers



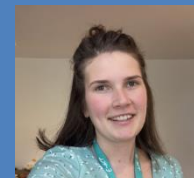
Miss May
