Home learning and reading

Home learning will either be given out in red home learning books on Fridays and expected back by the following Thursday. It will consist of up to ten spellings and an additional English or maths task (this usually alternates weekly). *We expect all children to complete home learning.*

Children **MUST read at home every day** in Year 4. Reading records will be checked daily to ensure children are reading with adults.

Keep reading through the summer holidays!

Important information

Year 4 have a statutory multiplication check in the summer term. This involves students answering 25 multiplication questions (up to 12 x 12), each question is presented for only 6 seconds. Children are expected to use Times Tables Rockstars regularly in preparation. The Sound Check on TTRS mimics the statutory test and is a great way to practise.

Curriculum

We are working really hard on improving our curriculum. You will soon receive a Knowledge Organiser (KO). The KO will provide you with important background information on the upcoming topic before it is taught in school. It is expected that children will have read the KO before new units of learning, as this will prepare them for the new learning.

Here are some key learning expectations ready for Year 4. *You might like to work on these over the summer.*

Maths

- Recall simple addition and subtraction facts fluently
- Read, write, order and compare numbers up to 1,000
- Add and subtract numbers with up to 3 digits
- Know the times tables facts for the 2, 5, 10, 3, 4- and 8-times tables and the related division facts
- Tell the time from an analogue clock to the nearest minute

Reading

- Listen to and discuss a wide range of fiction and non-fiction texts
- Use dictionaries to check meanings of words
- Draw inferences such as inferring characters' feelings and justify inferences with evidence
- Identify main ideas drawn from more than 1 paragraph and summarise these

Writing

- Express time, place or cause using conjunctions, adverbs and prepositions
- Use inverted commas to punctuate direct speech
- Use expanded noun phrases to specify and describe.
- Use the present perfect form of verbs.
- Use paragraphs as a way of grouping ideas.
