In Maths, we will be focusing upon place value initially and then the four operations.

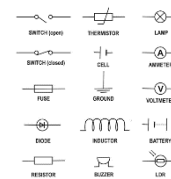
In English we will be starting the term by writing a setting description and then a tale of fear based upon our class reading book 'The Lion, the witch and the wardrobe'.
