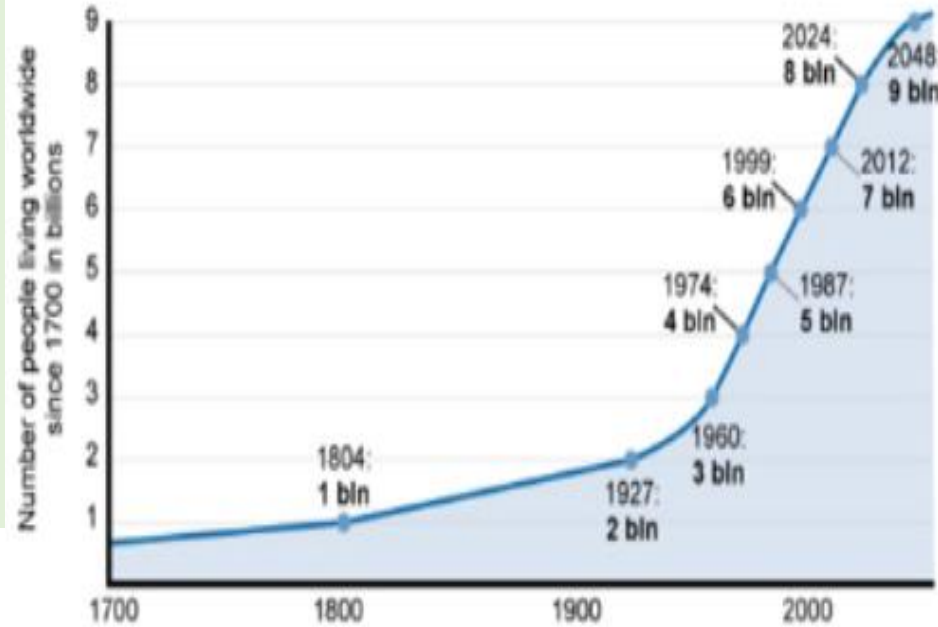
Where do people live?

The **population** of Earth is approximately 7.7 billion people. In 1800, there were approximately 0.8 billion people on Earth.

The world **population** is spread out across the world. In some places people live close together. In other places people live spread out.

Where people live is called a **settlement**. There are different types of **settlements**.

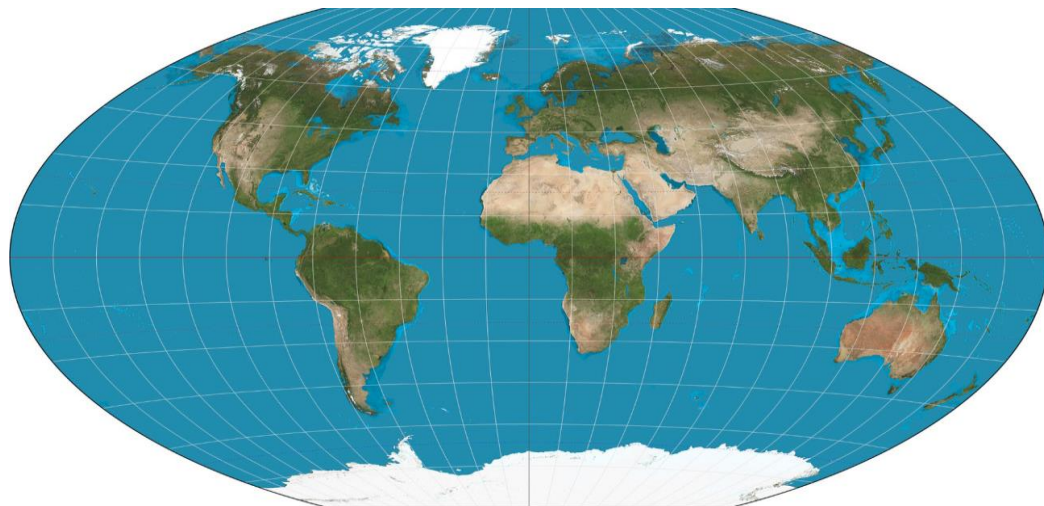
