Light and Dark

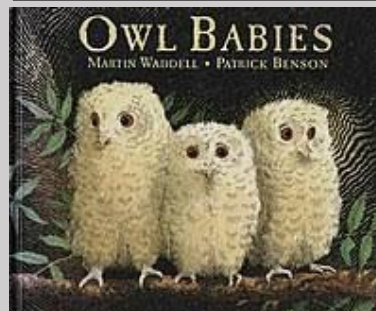
