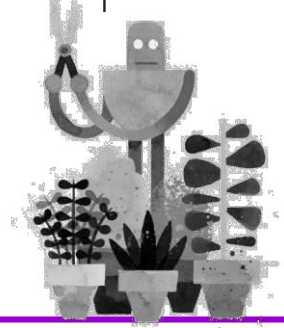
The Wild Robot

- Motherhood




